**NONDISCRIMINATION**

The Board is legally responsible for all matters relating to the operation of the School District. Selection of materials may involve administrators, library media specialists, teachers, students, and community persons.

The responsibility for the selection of instructional materials, however, is delegated to the professionally trained, certified personnel of the District. The selection and purchase of library materials shall be the responsibility of the certified library/media personnel.

Specific selection procedures shall be developed and are found in the “Selection and Reconsideration Policy” (361.27) document.

The School District shall not discriminate in the selection and evaluation of the instructional and library materials on the basis of sex, race, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, or physical, mental, emotional, or learning disability.
