The Board recognizes that differences of opinion exist in a democracy, and therefore, realizes that the suitability of particular instructional or library/media materials used in the schools may be questioned from time to time.

When citizens have concerns about particular instructional materials, these concerns shall be presented to the Building Principal in accordance with the "Selection and Reconsideration Policy" (#6163.4) and the procedure listed in the policy will be initiated.

The school district shall not discriminate in the selection and evaluation of instructional and library materials on the basis of sex, race, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, or physical, mental, emotional, or learning disability.
