






Our wonderful PSD Staff will be recognized throughout the year in our Staff Spotlight through our PSD Facebook Page!











Next week's task:

Next week we will start working on our team goals, which will be nested in our district learning goal. Here is an example of what that could look like (adapted from a Solution Trees book):

Level	Focus	Sample Goal
District	All students in the district	PSD students will earn an average composite score of 21 on the ACT and a proficient rating on the employability skills checklist prior to graduation.
School	All students in PHS	Same as District Goal
Team (Horizontal PLC)	All students supported by the team	All CTE students will demonstrate proficiency on Math Practice 1 (make sense of problems and persevere in solving them) and in the employability skill of "resilience."
Teacher- student (SLO)	All students of one teacher	All students in Mrs's classes will demonstrate proficiency or higher in formative assessments related to MP 1 and resilience.
