BOARD OPERATION

BOARD MEMBER RESIGNATION OR REMOVAL FROM OFFICE

A Board of Education members' resignation shall be made to the entire Board of Education. The resignation shall be made in writing, addressed, and delivered to the Board Clerk and District Administrator. If it is the Board Clerk's resignation, it shall be delivered to the Board President. The resignation shall be effective at the time indicated in the written resignation, or if no time is indicated, upon its delivery.

Any member of the Board may be removed for just cause in accordance with state law.
