1. Student and Staff Learning:

- a. The Wednesday Professional Development continues to focus on building the foundations for a guaranteed and viable curriculum. - b. Staff at the high school are now conducting 30 minute collaborations once a week with their colleagues who share a common planning time. Each staff member is to openly share responses to the following questions while sharing their lesson planning:

 - ii. What are your learning targets for this day - what do you want kids to know and be able to do? (Number of answers will vary based on how many classes were / are being planned.)
 - iii. How are you communicating these learning targets to the students?

- v. Do you have an exit ticket for the class(es)? If so, what evidence of student learning are you assessing?
- vi. Are you working on your SLO during this lesson(s)? If so, what part of the instruction is working on this?
- vii. Are you working on your PPG during this lesson(s)? If so, what part of the instruction is working on this?
- viii. How are you working on content literacy during this lesson(s)?
- ix. What intentional instructional strategies are you using to support content literacy or student engagement?
