

# Director of Child Care Center Board Report January 13, 2019

#### Enrollment

- We currently have 9 children enrolled in our infant/toddler room, ranging from 6-7kids in the room at a time.
- We have 18 children enrolled in our preschool program, averaging 9-12 children a day.
- We have a total of 28 children enrolled in our BASP program, averaging 10-13 children a night.

### <u>Staffing</u>

- We are still short staffed in some areas and don't have an established sub pool for sick or vacation days of childcare staff. Most of the times are being covered by me or we work it out amongst the staff we have. We could potentially use ECE teachers within the district, if the times needed worked within their current schedules. We do have a couple people that have stated they would be substitutes but we are waiting for them to finish filling out the required paperwork to be added to our list.
- We have reposted our non-lead teacher position online and through local newspapers. We are hoping that we can pick up one more teacher to help in the preschool room and float in our other rooms as needed.
- Position to start in March/April as part time with potential for full time come summer.
