CleverTouch Displays – All the displays have been installed in the classrooms and teachers are happily using them. They are working wonderfully.

Additional E-rate Funds – A final determination has been made on the amount of E-rate funds that will be available for the district for the 2020-21 school year: \$14,049.52, which is at the 60% rate that we will qualify for. If we spend \$23,415.88 on network infrastructure equipment, E-rate will pay the \$14,049.52 and the remaining \$9,366.36 can be picked up by the Teach Infrastructure grant. Applications for E-rate for next year must be filed by the end of the month.

HVAC Upgrade – I have been working with technicians from Complete Control on the installation and configuration of the new HVAC control system, known as Desigo. I have pulled network cable to the new locations which we needed for connecting the new control units to the network. I have also set up a new server so they could install the Desigo control software. I also have a new workstation ready to go for local access to the control system. Further configuration is continuing, and Dan Giles would have more information on that.

HS LMC Laptops – We are looking at using some of our Common School Funds of up to \$19,000 to purchase replacement Windows laptops in the high school library. These laptops are needed for those classes such as the business ed and tech ed classes that still need to use programs that will only work on Windows computers. Chromebooks cannot be used for those classes.
