- 1. Student and Staff Learning:
 - Daily student attendance over 23 days indicated 80% of PHS students are, on average, showing up to each of their 5 periods / day.
 - b. Staff have begun to create academic contingency plans to support students who may have not shown any evidence of learning (turned in school work) during 4th term. Solutions include an extended school year and summer school credit recovery.
 - c. Staff have begun introducing FRECKLE MATH to our 9th and 10th grade students in anticipation for next school year. They are using this time as an opportunity to practice creating classes and linking STAR MATH results with FRECKLE to provide students math practice. The 8th grade students are being assessed in STAR MATH and READING during term 4, before the end of the school year, to provide starting point data for next school year.

- 2. Innovation and Recognition:
