Dear Parents and Guardians,

Late yesterday afternoon, the Wisconsin Supreme Court struck down the "Safer At Home Order" which had the effect of closing all schools and businesses identified as non-essential. This morning, school districts received information from the Department of Public Instruction and legal counsel indicating that the ruling of the Supreme Court specifically does not apply to the order to close school's through June 30, 2020.
