

AFTER CLOSE CONTACT WITH SOMEONE WITH COVID-19

Students and Staff Up To Date with COVID-19 Vaccinations

If you are 18+ and have received all recommended vaccine doses, including booster and additional doses

OR

If you are ages 5 to 17 and completed the primary COVID-19 vaccine series

OR

If you tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 90 days using a viral test



- Wear a well-fitting mask around others for 10 days after your last close contact.
- You can keep going to school and participating in activities.
- Get tested at least 5 days after last close contact.
- If you develop symptoms or test positive, stay home. Follow instructions for isolation.



Get Tested Day 5*

Continue Wearing Mask

*If you develop symptoms or test positive for COVID-19, stay home and isolate for at least 5 full days. Wear a well-fitting mask when around others for an additional 5 days after ending isolation. If you have questions about when to return to school or if you test positive, contact your school.
