CANCELLATION OF SCHOOL BOARD MEETINGS

The School Board may exercise all lawful discretion to take official action to schedule, cancel, and reschedule Board meetings.

In addition, if the Board President determines (1) that cancelling a scheduled Board meeting is necessary or in the District's best interests (e.g., due to a significant health or safety concern); (2) that the considerations favoring cancellation outweigh any need for the meeting to be convened as scheduled; and (3) that circumstances otherwise reasonably permit advance cancellation of the meeting, then the President is authorized to cancel any of the following:

- 1. A Board meeting that was initially scheduled or otherwise directed to be held by an official action of the Board.
- 2. A Board meeting that the President individually requested as a special school board meeting.

Upon the withdrawal of the submitted request for the meeting, the Board President may also cancel a Board meeting that had been requested in writing by any other individual Board member(s) who initially submitted the request under relevant statutory authority.

If the Board President decides to cancel a Board meeting under this policy, the President or his/her designee shall notify all Board members of the cancellation decision and replace any public notice of the meeting that may have been issued with a notice of the cancellation, including notifying relevant news media. The Board President or District Administrator may direct other means of notifying District employees and/or the community of any decision to cancel a Board meeting.
