NONDISCRIMINATION

The testing program in the School District shall be designed to yield information on student achievement and study ability. Professional staff is expected to use the test results as an aid in the evaluation of individual students and instructional programs designed to ensure student success in the home, school, community, and as citizens in our democratic nation.

The District Administrator shall issue regulations to ensure the confidentiality of testing report and results. General testing reports shall be made to the Department of Public Instruction and to the public in accordance with State law.

The District testing program shall embody those tests required by State law and regulations.

The School District shall not discriminate in the methods, practices, and materials used for testing and evaluating students on the basis of sex, race, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, or physical, mental, emotional, or learning disability.
