Kajeet SmartSpot Parental Consent Form

The Pittsville School District is offering a limited number of free wireless hotspot devices to students who have limited or no Internet access at home. This program enables students to take home Internet service—absolutely free. Both the device and monthly service fees are fully paid by the district. The program is intended to help Pittsville students access online resources at home for school work or school research purposes. Use by anyone other than students or for non-school purposes is prohibited. Each device has daily and monthly limits on how much data is available, so access should not be wasted on unnecessary or non-school purposes. Streaming of music or video is not allowed. These devices use internet content filtering and are scheduled so that they cannot be used between 11 p.m. and 6 a.m. The borrowing limit is one device per household, but these devices can be signed out repeatedly throughout the year. **Students can check the devices out for the weekend or each night.** Kajeet devices must be returned to the library they were checked out from fully charged, powered off, and on time.

By signing this form, the parent agrees to the terms stated above and assume all responsibility for equipment signed out to the student.. ***A replacement fee of \$123 will be charged if the device is lost, damaged or not returned.***
