USE OF SCHOOL FOREST

834

- 1. The school forest shall be an extension of the educational classroom, and may be used by various teachers for that purpose.
- 2. The Board of Education authorizes the posting of the school forest property and restricts access to the property to:
 - a. maintain safety for classes using the property,
 - b. protect the environment, and
 - c. protect the forest classroom.
- 3. Classroom teachers or other adults that have been approved by the administration for that purpose shall directly supervise students using the property.
- 4. The Board of Education may authorize selective cutting of timber in the school forest and approve authorization of access for that purpose.
- 5. Specific individuals that may need the right to use the property to gain access to right-of-ways or other legitimate purposes, may seek approval from the District Administrator. A letter shall be provided to that individual as proof of authorization.
- 6. Being posted, the Board of Education does not authorize any hunting on the property without administrative approval.
 - a. Individuals must obtain a permit to legally hunt at the school forest. Hunting season includes all legal game from the start of small game season (early September) through all gun deer seasons ending in mid-December and spring Turkey season (April-May).
 - b. Obtaining a Permit: Fill out the attached permit to hunt on school forest property and hand deliver completed form to the District Office. Please do not mail the permit.
 - c. Individuals must submit documentation (driver's license) for the district to complete a background check.
 - d. Hunting Hours: Monday through Friday until 7:00 AM and after 3:45 PM. Saturday and Sunday all day.
- 7. Being posted, the Board of Education does not authorize use of recreational vehicles such as snowmobiles, all-terrain vehicles, and other motorized vehicles unless approved by the administration or board or used by the staff in connection with a class being conducted on the forest property.

REGISTRATION PERMIT TO HUNT OR ACCESS THE PITTSVILLE SCHOOL DISTRICT SCHOOL FOREST POSTED PROPERTY (Policy 834)

I understand and recognize that the Pittsville School District is not required to permit me to hunt on school district property. I recognize and agree that the right to do so is a privilege, which can be revoked at any time, with or without notice. Inconsideration of the school district's agreeing to permit me to hunt on its school forest property, as identified below, I hereby agree to the following:

- 1. I will abided by all state and federal laws while hunting on school forest property including, without limitation, laws applicable to firearms and hunting,
- 2. I will not litter on school forest property or disturb the natural habitat of the school forest.
- 3. I will shoot and hunt only game authorized by this permit on the school forest property. I will not harm any other game or animals.
- 4. I will exercise due and proper care while hunting on the school forest property.
- 5. I will abide by all school district policies and procedures while hunting on school forest property. A copy of the specific rules pertaining to hunting on school forest property is attached.
- 6. I will not permit any individual who has not been granted a permit by the School District of Pittsville to hunt on the school forest property with me while I am doing so.
- 7. At any time there are students or district staff present, I will cease hunting and remove myself from the property. If I have to be asked to leave, my privilege to use the school forest may be revoked.
- 8. I hereby waive and release, and agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless, the school district, its officers, employees, and agents, from and with respect to any claim, loss, liability, injury, penalty, harm, or damage of any kind or nature whatsoever, including but not limited to that occurring to myself, arising out of my hunting activities on school forest property, including, but not limited to, compensatory, incidental, consequential, and punitive damages. This waiver and release, and indemnification provisions applies without limitation to any claims or causes of action based upon acts or omissions of the school district, its officers and employees, including, without limitation, the District's granting me permission to hunt on the school forest property and my hunting on that land. By signing this permit, I also waive and release such claims against the school district, its officers, employees, and agents, on behalf of my minor children, if any, that have also been granted permission to hunt on school forest property and with whom I will be hunting and will be under my supervision.

Violators are subject to trespassing laws.

RULES PERTAINING TO HUNTING ON SCHOOL FOREST PROPERTY

- 1. Application to hunt must be on file in advance of proposed hunt.
- 2. Hunting Hours: Week days only until 7:00 AM and after 3:45 PM. Weekends all day unless being used by students.
- 3. If the main gate on Highway 80 is open, then the permit is null and void.
- 4. Hunting stands must be taken down daily.
- 5. The PURPLE Pittsville School Forest Hunting Permit must be displayed in your vehicle's dashboard.
- 6. Do not block the main gate.
