

Director of Child Care Center Board Report May 13th, 2019

<u>Peek-A-Boo Event</u> - On April 17th, we had a total of 13 families/27 people who were in attendance. We had some cookies and punch for our refreshments. We displayed our vision boards of our new PCCC infant/toddler and preschool rooms. We shared our new playground area for our PCCC and our replacement piece for the school age equipment. And finally with the help of Mr. Ty Natzke, we put together a BASP presentation that had testimonies from our current program kids.

<u>School Age Summer Care Enrollment</u> - We currently have 6 summer children enrolled for our school age summer care program. We are hoping that this will increase as it gets closer.

<u>Full-Day Child Care Enrollment</u> - We have 9 children who are enrolled for child care program come fall. Three for infant/toddler area, three for preschool and three that are new 4k students. Most of the children are scheduled for 3 to 4 days a week.

<u>Probationary License</u> - On the night of our Peek-A-Boo event we had our final probationary visit with the state. It was a short visit and she also took the time to walk through our event. We were in compliance with all state regulations.

<u>2 Year License</u> - We have been issued our 2-year license. We will be under review again come July/August depending on how soon our PCCC remodel will be finished. At that time, we will undergo a building inspection for all PCCC rooms and have our visit with our state licensing specialist. Given everything is in order, we will be all set to open the full-day center come fall.
